Tanzania Wildlife Experience Safari Day Trip

Tanzania Wildlife Experience Safari to NGORONGORO CRATER

As the animals do not migrate in and out of the Ngorongoro crater, etc to see as many animals as you can expect on the crater floor for just 3 to 4 hours of your visit, the drive from Arusha takes 3 hours and you will spend few minutes at the entrance gate for signing in before you enter the park.

Comprised of forests, savanna, and highland plains, the Ngorongoro Conservation Area covers a nearly 3,200 square miles area in Tanzania. It is a protected area governed by the Tanzania National Parks Authority and one of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites. One of the main attractions of the conservation area is the Ngorongoro Crater; it is the world's largest intact, inactive, and un-flooded volcanic caldera. This crater formed approximately three million years ago after a large volcano exploded and collapsed. Ngorongoro crater is about 12 miles across and 2,000 feet deep. The Crater floor is about 100 square miles. Unlike smaller craters on top of dormant volcanoes, which also often are tourism destinations, Ngorongoro Crater is home to tens of thousands of large animals and people as well. It is a natural wonder worth visiting and protecting at the same time.

You will drive through the high and steep lanes until you reach the Carter viewpoint where you will stop for the pictures before you drive further to the crater descending road. After descending into the crater you will drive through different vegetation including forest, lake, and hills. The animals you can expect to see inside the crater include Rhino, elephant, lion, leopard, zebra, wildebeest, Jackal, and baboon just to mention a few. The lunch will be served at the hippo pools while enjoying the view of the hippopotamus in Ngoitoktok hippo pond.

Day 01: Game Drive Safari

Our journey will commence at 6:00 am from your hotel or residence in Arusha, following your breakfast meal. We will then embark on an exhilarating drive to the Ngorongoro Crater, with a lunch box in tow.

Upon arrival, we will confidently descend 600m into the breathtaking Ngorongoro Crater for an entire day of game driving. The crater, which is one of the most densely populated wildlife areas in the African region, is home to an estimated 30,000 animals, including Tanzania's last remaining black rhino. The Ngorongoro Conservation area is home to a diverse range of animals, such as herds of wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, eland, warthog, hippo, and giant African elephants. It is a year-round source of water and fodder for these animals.

With our keen senses, we will not miss any of the action as we keep a watchful eye out for the large population of predators that inhabit the area, including lions, hyenas, jackals, cheetahs, and the elusive leopard. We will confidently enjoy a picnic lunch at Ngoitokitoki Swamp, located on the crater floor while taking in the breathtaking scenery.

As the day draws to a close, we will embark on our journey back to Arusha or Moshi, where we will drop you off at your hotel or residence, marking the end of this epic tour.

Tanzania Wildlife Experience Safari to Tarangire National Park Day Trip



Day 01: Game viewing - Tarangire National Park

After having breakfast, you will leave Arusha and begin a two-hour drive to Tarangire National Park. As you travel, you will see the changing landscape, from the urban jungle of Arusha to the wide open plains and charming Masai villages.

Tarangire National Park has the highest density of elephants in North Tanzania, and you can see these magnificent creatures all year round. During the dry season between July and October, the herds can reach 300 animals. The park is located about 74.5 miles (120 km) from Arusha and southeast of Lake Manyara National Park. It runs along the line of the Tarangire River and is mainly made up of low-lying hills on the Great Rift Valley floor. Its natural vegetation mainly consists of Acacia woodland and giant African Baobab trees, with huge swamp areas in the south. The river and the swamps act like a magnet for wild animals, especially during Tanzania's dry season.

The Tarangire River has water all year round, and during the dry season, many animals from the surrounding areas come to the river for drinking. If you visit the park during this time, you will witness an unforgettable natural wonder. You can

observe a variety of wonderful creatures such as lions, giraffes, buffaloes, wildebeests, and zebras. You may also spot various types of antelopes, gazelles, and, with a little luck, even a python! This area is also a haven for bird watchers with over 550 species, including the Masai Ostrich, the world's largest bird.

Halfway through our day trip in Tarangire, we will stop for lunch at our special spot, where we can enjoy great views overlooking the national park. Be careful of any monkeys nearby, as they'll be interested in your lunch too! After lunch, we will continue our game drive safari, trying to spot animals that we might not have seen yet, so we can cross as many animal experiences as possible off our list. At the end of the day, we will prepare for the drive back to Arusha.
